

Early Childhood Education and Care – Course Details

Certificate in Early Childhood Education and Care – Level 1

Duration: 4 Weeks (150USD)

Overview:

An introductory course designed for beginners entering early childhood education. Focuses on basic child development, health and safety, and understanding the educator's role.
